TRANSPORTATION

Current 7th graders who walk to Wilson, will walk to Lincoln. If a current 7th grader is within walking distance of Adams, he/she will be able to walk to Adams and take a shuttle bus to Lincoln. Incoming 7th graders within walking distance of Lincoln, will walk to Lincoln and take a shuttle bus to Adams. Shuttles will leave each site at 7:20 a.m. Those not in walking distance will be transported by bus to Lincoln and Adams. Buses will drop students at Lincoln and then travel on to Adams.

THE MIDDLE SCHOOL EXPERIENCE

It's not the building that makes for a positive middle school experience. It's the people, the instruction, and the programming. Each building will house two teams of teachers. We will continue to have the current school day programs that we have now—middle school lunch choices, team celebrations, the homework incentive program, Advisory, and extracurricular clubs (drama, literary magazine, National Jr. Honor Society, PRIDE, Student Council, Student Ambassadors, etc.). Shuttle buses after school will provide transportation between Adams and Lincoln for after-school club activities. We hope to bring the 7th and 8th graders together for monthly dances (September-March) at various sites (possibly Adams, HHS or HFS). Wilson's teachers are the engine that drives instruction and programming for our students.
